Dude

A word’s meaning can change with its context. The word “dude” appears in a wide range of circumstances. With this single word, one may ask a question, vent anger, express joy, greet a friend, or convey disappointment. This word’s meaning changes with its situation.

The versatility of this single word reminds me of an important rule for interpreting biblical passages: “Words only have meaning in their context.” The meaning of a word varies according to other words around it. Another example is the word “hot.” It can refer to its engine temperature, its interior on a sunny summer day, or its appearance. In certain contexts, a car may be both “hot” and “cool.”

When reading God’s word, we should always remember that words have meaning only in their context. Restricting a word to a single meaning could lead to erroneous interpretations. Consider the various uses of the word “heaven.” Sometimes it refers to the dwelling of God, but in other contexts, it points to the realm of the sun, moon, planets, and stars. In addition, it may simply call our attention to the sky where birds soar and clouds drift.

Clearly, interpretation depends upon context. Let’s exercise sound judgment and let the meaning of words develop from their context. This practice can help us understand what God intends for us to know and will lead us away from reading our own ideas and emotions into the text.
