Wish in One Hand

Mom says, “Wish in one hand and spit in the other and see which one gets full first.” Wishing leaves you empty handed, and that’s about as useful as a hand full of spit. Wishing for spiritual improvements isn’t enough. We have plenty of “idea people.” We need more workers. We need “idea people” to become “doing people.”

Paul describes the church as the body of Christ (1Cor. 12). He speaks of a foot, a hand, an eye, head, hearing, and smell. Notice that each member of the body is a complete, contributing member of the body. Too often, we consider ourselves as a small toe or a fingernail. While we may see ourselves as a part of the body, it is often in a passive role. This is unbiblical. This denies God’s gift to each member of the body... *“As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God”* (1 Peter 4:10).

If you want the church to be more evangelistic... If you want the church to be more zealous for good deeds... If you want the body of Christ to be more loving... you will need to participate actively in proclaiming Jesus, doing good deeds, and giving love to others.

God has a vision for a lively body of believers. In His point of view, every member is using their gifts for the benefit of every other member. God has ideas for each one of us to do: *“Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil; cling to what is good. Be devoted to one another in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor; not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; rejoicing in hope, persevering in tribulation, devoted to prayer, contributing to the needs of the saints, practicing hospitality”* (Rom. 12:9-13).
