A couple in Shiprock is looking for a small place to rent in Kirtland or Farmington area. See one of the Elders if you know of a place.

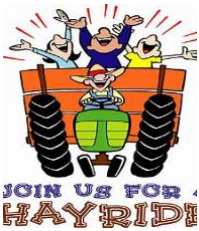

Spiritual Goals

I was recently reminded that we reap what we sow (Gal. 6:7). If we only set earthly goals, we will only reap earthly rewards. Setting spiritual goals ensures that we are maturing in Christ and moving closer to heaven (Phil. 2:12; 2Pet. 1:10).

Our spiritual goals must include Bible study. The Bible is the power of God to save us (Rom. 1:16). The Bible is the word of God on how to live pleasing to God (2Tim. 3:16-17). The Bible reveals the way to heaven (Jn. 14:3,6).

Our spiritual goals should also include soul-winning efforts. Seeking and saving the lost dominates God’s efforts (Lk. 19:10; Jn. 3:16). Telling others about Jesus doesn’t require a PhD. It can be as simple as inviting a friend to read the Bible. A good place to start is the gospel of John which is written for the purpose of creating faith (Jn. 20:30-31). You are not responsible for your friend’s response to the Bible. Your job is planting and watering. God takes care of the growth (1Cor. 3:6).

There are many possibilities for spiritual goals. I recommend focusing on goals that strengthen your faith, increase your love, and stabilize your hope.

Without spiritual goals, it’s impossible to grow spiritual fruit. Without spiritual fruit, it’s impossible to get to heaven... *“Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit, He takes away”* (Jn. 15:2a). What are your spiritual goals? Are you working to achieve them?
